Preferred classes will run with the corresponding regular class and height divisions. Jump height will be high to low Thursday and Saturday; low to high on Friday and Sunday.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely

Puppies under 6 months are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Total entry fees less \$7 for each day entered will be refunded for bitches coming into season after the closing date. The Trial Secretary must be notified of such claim for refund prior to the start of judging or by mail, which must be received by Mar 10, 2010. The request must be accompanied by a veterinarian's statement.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please help keep the trial site and hotels clean.

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the trial. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules** on the back. Telegraph, telephone, fax and email entries cannot be accepted.

Each competitor will receive a running order at registration.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

The trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number, except for bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may effect the dog's physical performance.

Jump Height Cards

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for you (owner/exhibitor) to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the ***Dogs To Be Measured List***. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.*

Obstacles

Obstacles meet requirements as described in the current edition of the regulations.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Crating space is limited, so please be considerate of others and do not take more room than you really need. The site will be available for exhibitors to setup starting at 9:00AM on Thursday morning.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. State health requirements include proof of annual rabies vaccination.

\$20 First entry per day per dog (includes the \$3.00 AKC recording fee)

\$12 Second entry per day per dog (includes the \$3.00 AKC event service fee)

Move-Ups

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing no later than **6:00 PM, Monday, Mar 8, 2010**. Day to day move-ups during the trial will be allowed providing the request is received by the Trial Secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the completion of judging.

Prizes & Awards

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Dogs must qualify to receive placement awards. MADOC will award a special rosette for dogs finishing a title. MADOC will also award a special prize/award for any dog finishing a MACH or PAX title at our trial. Double Q ribbons will be awarded as well. Assorted doggie toys and treats valued at no more than \$2 each will be offered as prizes for 1st through 4th placements. A rosette and photo plaque will be awarded to any dog earning a first MACH in memory of MACH Majestic Holiday Bliss, CDX, "Madison" given by Gina Newsome.

From North or South: Take I-65 to Exit 179-Prattville, AL. From the north turn right, from the south, left. Go approximately ¾ mile. Turn left on US-82W/AL6 and continue approximately 5 miles. Turn Left onto AL-14 and go approximately 10 miles. The Pavilion will be on the right behind a small office building.

From East: Take I-85 to I-65, go north and follow instructions above.

From West (Selma, AL): Take AL-14 East approximately 25 miles. The Pavilion will be on the left behind a small office building.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
